

Lent 2 25 February 2024 Changed?! Mark 9:2-10

The transformation, transfiguration places Jesus squarely in the great lineage of Israel's great leaders, Moses and Elijah. The Greek word is metamorphoo from which we get metamorphic, and metamorphosis, only appears three times in the New Testament. Metamorphic rocks start as one type of rock and with pressure heat and time become another. e.g. Limestone becomes marble. Metamorphosis is most commonly seen as a caterpillar becomes a chrysalis then a butterfly.

The first is the transfiguration of Jesus. The Greek Lexicon describes Jesus "was resplendent with a divine brightness." An utterly overwhelming lightness of being. And the voice from a cloud: "This is my Son, the Beloved." God's intervention in the story declaring his place in the world of Peter, James and John and one with Moses and Elijah: "Listen to him."

The second occurrence is Romans 12.2. Paul indicates the way of renewal for the follower of Jesus. He says don't be conformed to this world. The way of transformation is by the renewing of your mind, as a way of knowing God's will. This strikes me as a process more like changing from limestone to marble. A process in which numerous forces are at work, shaping and reshaping our inner being to reflect God's will being present in our lives.

The third is the promise for the future in 2 Corinthians 3.18. It is the promise of the process. As we see Jesus more and more clearly, "Jesus is seen more and more in us as we are being transformed into his likeness with ever increasing glory". John Cox Be encouraged.
