Have you ever prayed for someone's healing?

It is part of Jesus' command to the disciples and to us
Luke 9:2 'preach the gospel and heal the sick'.

I have tried!

I have prayed for healing very intentionally with some
people! Sometimes casually.

I have even done it as a teaching exercise in a service. It
was very helpful to me and the others who joined in the
praying, anointing and laying on of hands. WE learned a
lot.

But did the people we were praying for get healed?

Some did; some got healed for things we weren't
praying for. There are many aspects to healing and we
need teaching about it.

Jesus told the disciples it is not always straight forward.
They came back from one excursion upset that their
prayers hadn't worked.

The stories in Luke this week illustrate a couple of
points. The faith of the centurion had something to do
with the healing, but the faith of the widow appears to
not have anything to do with her son's raising from the
dead - see the story in Luke 7.

Love to the World in Monday's reading says "The
miracle of 'new life' is graciously given only by the Lord
of Life."

It is not up to us to dictate or try and organise it to
happen.
