Transformation - the work of a community (Acts 9:1-19)

Is it possible for people to change their ways? Can angry zealots become loving advocates? Writing this before Australia's national parliamentary election, I wonder if we may ever see the *transformation* of our politicians from campaigners to wise guides and leaders.

There is much that has been written and said about the conversion of Saul the persecutor of Christians into Paul, the Apostle of Christ. That dramatic transformation occurred when an appearance of the risen Jesus in a bright light blinded him as he fell to the ground. Far less is written about Ananias of Damascus – the local disciple who looked after the stricken Paul, healed him and nurtured him into the Christian community, calling him 'brother'. Less still do people notice the local disciples of Jesus who surrounded this former enemy with love and support.

The transformation of Saul would not have occurred without a community that was sufficiently generous, open and brave to respond to God's call. We pray for our own church community: Spirit of God, encourage us to welcome all who come among us as sisters and brothers, introducing them to your healing, freeing, life-giving work.
